12 Disciples

Give each child a long strip of paper – ideally the dimensions should be 60cm long and 10cm wide or high. Ask them to fold it like a fan or concertina – backwards and forwards along the length. If they make the first fold 5cm from the end, that should give them 12 sections in the end. You might like to mark where the first fold should go!

Get them to draw a simple stick man on the topmost section:



Make sure that the arms and legs look like they might continue off the paper.

Then cut out the shape:



When they unfold the paper, they should have twelve men holding hands!



They can then write a disciple's name on each man – younger children might need more help here.

[Judas, Simon, Thaddaeus, Thomas, James, Bartholomew, Philip, John, James, Peter, Matthew, Andrew]
